The Pedigree® Stage Stop Race kicked off its 25th Anniversary on historic Town Square in downtown Jackson, Wyoming tonight as it's done since 1996. A near perfect Wyoming winter night saw a record crowd that was treated to the dual starts of 18 impressive teams. A dazzling laser light show created a festive atmosphere and a colorful backdrop for tonight's exhibition race and festivities.

From Jackson, the race moves to the first official stage in Alpine, Wyoming Saturday, February 1st. All 18 teams will compete for best time in a 30-mile out-and-back course. The race begins at 9:00 am and starts at Greys River Trail Head parking lot in Alpine, Wyoming.
